The River Sense had been the highest since 2002 and the drain by the Pug & Greyhound was blocked and had caused high levels of flooding. An enquiry was made on the Willow tree at Brookfield's. The Tree was cut back by LCC, the tree warden advised they could complete the work as it is not protected.
